

**DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY**  
**FOR THE BOROUGH OF MANOR, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

WHEREAS, beginning on or about Saturday, March 14, 2020 Novel Coronavirus, known as COVID-19, (hereinafter “COVID 19”), has caused or threatens to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and employees of Borough of Manor; and

WHEREAS, the disaster has endangered the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in Borough of Manor and employees of the Borough, and threatens to create problems greater in scope than Manor Borough, may be able to fully address and resolve; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents and employees of Manor Borough;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council hereby extends and confirms the Mayor of Manor Borough’s Declaration of March 14, 2020 until April 16, 2020, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA C.S., Section 7501), as amended; and does also hereby declare and extend the existence of a disaster emergency in Manor Borough caused by COVID 19;

FURTHER, the Council hereby directs the Manor Borough Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this emergency.


STILL FURTHER, the Council hereby authorizes officials and the Manager of Manor Borough to act promptly and as necessary to meet the current exigencies of this emergency, namely: by the management of the resources and employees of the Borough; the employment of temporary workers; by the rental of equipment; by the purchase of supplies and materials; and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the performance of public work as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.

This Declaration is made this 18<sup>th</sup> day of March and shall take effect at 1900 hours on 18th day of March, 2020 and shall extend to April 16, 2020.
