Due to the COVID-19 outbreak, the Mayor of Manor has taken the steps to proclaim a disaster emergency in Manor Borough. While there currently are **no presumptive or confirmed cases of COVID-19** in Manor Borough or Westmoreland County, the declaration gives the Borough access to additional resources for preparedness, mitigation, response and recovery in the event of a COVID-19 outbreak. Manor Borough will work closely with our neighboring municipalities along with the Westmoreland County Department of Public Safety, PEMA, and FEMA during this pandemic.

To prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus, the following COVID-19 guidelines set forth by Governor Wolf and the PA Department of Health should be followed by residents of the borough.

Stay away from recreational activities and public areas where groups may accumulate, entertainment venues, community centers, gyms, etc. Social Distancing is recommended at this time.

Cancel or postpone any large gatherings, parties, community functions, or events.

Religious leaders are encouraged to use discretion to prevent the spread of the illness in their congregations and use alternative options for delivering your message.

Access to Manor Borough facilities may be limited at this time.

DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY
FOR THE BOROUGH OF MANOR, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, on or about Saturday March 14, 2020 Novel Coronavirus, known as COVID-19, (hereinafter "COVID19"), has caused or threatens to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and property of Manor Borough; and

WHEREAS, the disaster has endangered the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in Manor Borough, and threatens to create problems greater in scope than Manor Borough, may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents of Manor Borough;


NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Mayor of Manor Borough, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA C.S., Section 7501), as amended, does hereby declare the existence of a disaster emergency in Manor Borough;

FURTHER, I direct the Manor Borough Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this emergency.

STILL FURTHER, I authorize officials of Manor Borough to act as necessary to meet the current exigencies of this emergency, namely: by the employment of temporary workers, by the rental of equipment, by the purchase of supplies and materials, and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the performance of public work as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.

This Declaration shall take effect at 1200 hours on 14th day of March, 2020.


